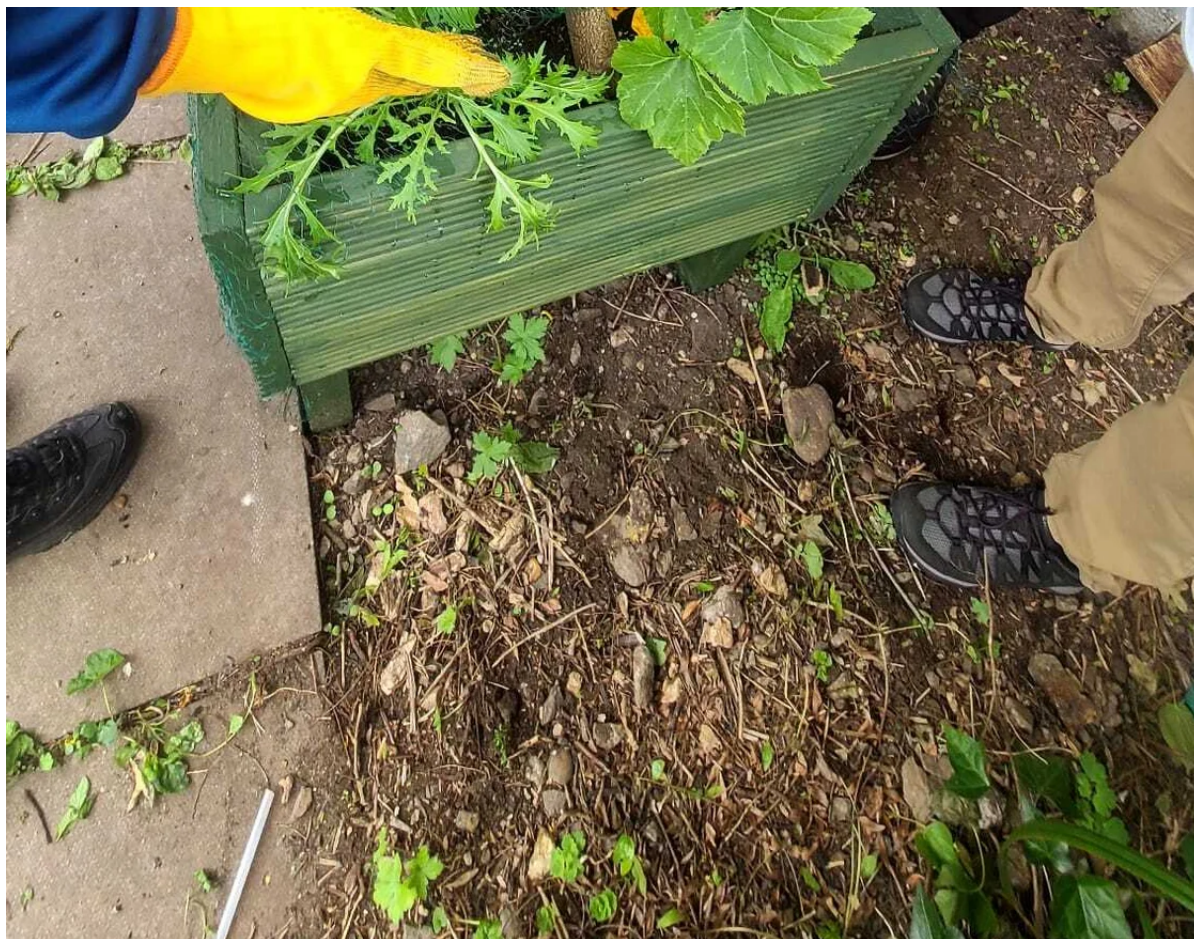
**14th June, behind Rugby Eco Hub, 10:30am-1:30pm and
