All things volunteering



Many thanks to everyone who was able to attend our Volunteer Event last week. It was great to showcase the different ways you can get involved in Rugby Eco Hub's work. Regular Volunteer Drop-in Sessions

From next week, the Eco Hub will be open to support some regular volunteer drop-in sessions. These will be held on weekly but on alternating days:

- Tuesday, 11am 1pm (<u>starting from Tuesday 15th April</u>)
- Thursday's, 2pm 4pm (starting from Thursday 10th April)

The idea is that someone from the operations team will be available at the Hub at these times so that you can come along to undertake some pre-identified or adhoc volunteer tasks. This will be in addition to the volunteer opportunities that are hosted on a Saturday morning (i.e. the Repair Cafe (1st and 3rd Saturday of the month), Library of Things, Gardening and Growing Group, and the Cafe).

PLEASE NOTE: The Tuesday and Thursday sessions will alternate week to week, so please check the <u>events calendar</u> on our website for clarity.

Upcoming volunteering opportunities

Below are a list of the current volunteering opportunities we have available:

1. Distributing posters and flyers

A key priority for us is to **raise awareness of Rugby Eco Hub** so that more people can benefit from the services we offer. As such, we are looking for some volunteers to help us <u>put up some posters</u> and <u>distribute flyers</u> to people's door.

Posters

If you are happy to put up some posters locally, you can pick one or more up from the Eco Hub on Saturday morning's or at the times listed below (see under "flyers").

There will be a list of locations we would like to distribute to, which you can signup to, or you can suggest ideas yourself. We just ask that you write the location on the list so that we don't duplicate our efforts.
